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J. Zlotorzyska: Nadrodzina Philopteroidea: rodzina Rallicolidae. Klucze do oznaczania owadów Polski XV, 5, Państwowe Wydawnictwo Naukowe, Warszawa—Wrocław 1978, 86 pp., 302 Figs. Price 24 zł.

The last volume but one dealing with Mallophaga from the series Keys for identification of Polish insects published by the Polish Entomological Society is devoted to the ischnoceran family Rallicolidae. Its concept and arrangement is practically the same as in the previous part (see *Folia parasit. (Praha)* 25: 331, 1978). Within the framework of the family two subfamilies are recognized: Rallicolinae and Quadraceptinae. A total of 21 genera and 145

species and subspecies are recorded in the systematic list. The subspecies are mentioned in the keys under individual species. The numerous illustrations complement well the text. The volume is closed by a list of Latin names of parasites and hosts. The publication brings valuable information on this insect family and undoubtedly belongs to useful determination literature for European specialists in Mallophaga.
